

ANNOUNCING A NEW MICROBIOLOGY GRADUATE PROGRAM

The Graduate Program in Microbiology is a new <u>interdepartmental and interdisciplinary</u> initiative at MIT. It is designed to provide students with broad exposure to modern areas of microbiology and depth in the chosen area of thesis work. Research areas include: biochemistry, genetics, structural biology, genomics, systems biology, computational biology, chemical and biological engineering, biotechnology, synthetic biology, cell and molecular biology, ecology, evolutionary biology, immunology, virology, pathogenesis, and environmental microbiology.

The first class of students will arrive in the Fall 2008 and will join an already vibrant, thriving microbiology community at MIT. There are over 50 faculty members from several different science and engineering departments and divisions participating in the program. Graduate students will be supported with a stipend, tuition, and health insurance.
