Master of Science Program in Physiology

The University of Michigan Molecular & Integrative Physiology's M.S. degree program is designed for students planning to pursue one of the following paths: (1) employment as a research assistant in academia or industry, (2) application to a doctoral degree-granting program, or (3) application to a health profession program such as Medical School or Dental School.

This program has the flexibility to allow a student to pursue either (1) an intensive, research-oriented M.S. degree which will prepare the student for the workforce or a Ph.D. program or (2) an intensive, course-oriented M.S. degree that will prepare the student for a health professional graduate program. The program is intensive and designed to be completed in one year. The short duration and high intensity of the program allows the student to demonstrate their motivation and ability to perform at a high level with a heavy workload.
