The MIT Center for Biomedical Innovation (CBI) has an available position to aid us in the creation of a new online *Principles of Biomanufacturing* course to be offered on edX. This position is well suited for an undergraduate with interest in the biotech industry, biopharmaceutical manufacturing, and/or edX. The position will aid in all aspects of course development from collecting and evaluating existing biopharmaceutical manufacturing educational resources, helping to draft and evaluate potential homework questions to be used for the online course, to aiding in scripting lecture material and initial testing of the online course. The course is expected to go live in April 2015.

Key qualifications: This role will require superior attention to detail, the ability to summarize data using secondary resources, and a familiarity with the edX platform. Familiarity with the biopharmaceutical industry and experience with coding languages (such as Java Script, html, Matlab, Python, etc.) is a plus, but not required.
