The NEXT Scholars Program of the New York Academy of Sciences pairs **first and second year undergraduate women** with **female mentors in STEM fields** to work together over the course of one year through **online** meetings and lesson modules. Your mentor will expose you to a variety of STEM fields and help you develop the skills you need to succeed.

How the NEXT Scholars Program works:

- You'll be paired with a female STEM professional, and meet online for one-on-one mentorship, twice a month, for a one-year time period.
- Through the **NEXT Scholars Network** of mentors and mentees, you'll be exposed to a multitude of careers in STEM-related fields.
- **Online lesson modules** will develop your soft skills, including: critical thinking, leadership and communicating effectively essential to your success in the workforce.
