WHAT DOES THE MCKINSEY LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP INCLUDE?

The McKinsey LDW will be a one-day workshop held at McKinsey's Boston office at the end of IAP, **February 5th, 2018**. The program will conclude by 4:30p with an optional dinner and connectivity event in the evening.

- **Leadership development training:** Get a glimpse into the continuous personal and professional development that McKinsey offers its consultants. This includes hands on activities, and active coaching sessions and discussions. You will have the opportunity to select two training sessions most aligned with your leadership development goals for small group breakouts.
- **Inspiring discussion panels:** We work on the most important topics and challenges facing today's society ranging from youth unemployment, to the rise of digital healthcare, to the impact of artificial intelligence on the economy. You will have the opportunity to hear consultants discuss how McKinsey has allowed them to pursue their passions, how their MIT experience helped shaped their time at McKinsey, and how they have leveraged leadership development skills at McKinsey to help solve our client's problems.
- **McKinsey mentorship:** Get paired based on similar interests with McKinsey consultants who also went to MIT. Through several small-group interactions, you will have the opportunity to develop lasting professional mentorship relationships that can help you not just at the McKinsey LDW, but throughout your MIT and professional career.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS?

The program is open to current MIT freshman and sophomores of all majors in the classes of 2020 and 2021.

All applications will be reviewed, and selected participants will be notified within the week following the deadline.
