## **About Tools for Socially Responsible Knowledge Gathering - 5 min**

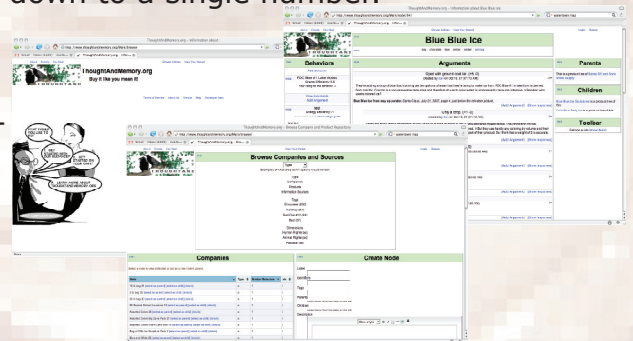
There are numerous optimistic technologies emerging. We are building an extensible open source platform to enable the sharing of data between these systems.
