SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Background

The American Lebanese Engineering Society, Inc. (ALES) was founded in Orlando, Florida, in 1991 by a group of engineers as a non-profit organization.

Mission

The mission is to form a national organization of professional engineers to serve as role models in the American Lebanese community.

Objectives

- Advance the science and the profession of engineering.
- Unite engineering resources and facilitate the potential of American-Lebanese professionals.
- Promote the advancement of engineers, architects, and scientists in employment and education.
- Provide a professional networking environment among members.
- Maintain interaction and association with national and international engineering societies.
- Support Lebanese engineering students through cooperation, guidance, and scholarships.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

Students must meet the following minimum criteria for eligibility:

- Must attend an ABET accredited university.
- Must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.25 on a scale of 4.00.
- Must be Lebanese or of Lebanese descent.
- Must be a junior, a senior, or a graduate student.
- Must be enrolled and working toward a degree in engineering, engineering science, computer science, or architecture.

Submission Requirements

Qualified candidates must submit all of the following items for evaluation:

- A completed application form.
- A copy of the most recent academic transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- A recent photograph. A clear black/white passport type photo is preferred. It may be used to promote the scholarship in an article to be published on ALES website and local newspapers.
- A one page essay describing the applicant's academic background, achievements and goals in 500 words or less. Clearly identify the relevance of your studies to ALES goals and why you should be given the award.

ALES shall not discriminate against applicants and prospective or current members on the basis of religion, political belief, gender, income status, race, or marital status.
