Special teaching emphasis in general business operations, Business Logistics, Freight Transportation, International Logistics, Import/Export Operations, Production Management, Transport Terminals/Warehouse Operations, Port Terminal Operations, Logistics/Inventory Management, Purchasing/Sourcing, and Materials Handling (packaging/equipment). Candidates may also have experience teaching in one or more of the following areas: Organizational Behavior, Organization Development, Marketing, International Business, International Human Resource Management, and/or Strategic Business Management. Appropriate research and service are required which may include Academy Committees, Department Committees, Student Advising, Faculty Advisor for Student Club Activity, and Professional/industry Affiliation. Willingness and flexibility to potentially teach courses during summer semester is also desirable.
