The Department of Operational Sciences at the Air Force Institute of Technology invites applications for the Director of the Center for Operational Analysis (COA). This is a non-tenure track position with a renewable 3 year term appointment at the rank of Research Assistant, Research Associate, or Research Full Professor. Candidates should possess an earned doctorate degree in Operations Research, Logistics Management, Industrial Engineering, Management Science, or a related field at the time of employment. The Department seeks applicants who have prior experience in leadership roles, combined with outstanding records of extramural funding.

The Director provides vision and leadership to advance the COA towards being a worldclass research center conducting defense-focused analysis in operations research and supply chain management. Successful applicants must have a strong commitment to interdisciplinary research, multidisciplinary collaboration, and fostering and expanding interactions between faculty within the school and with Department of Defense agencies. Rank and salary are commensurate with qualifications.
