DETAILED JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Saunders College of Business invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the Assistant or Associate level in Supply Chain Management. Responsibilities include supporting the deployment of a major in Supply Chain Management (SCM) by developing and teaching courses in the field, as well as conducting high quality scholarly research in SCM. The Saunders College values collegial individuals who are excellent communicators, innovative teachers, and active researchers. The College works closely with the business community, which provides research and professional opportunities.

We are seeking an individual who has the ability and interest in contributing to a community committed to studentcenteredness; professional development and scholarship; integrity and ethics; respect, diversity and pluralism; innovation and flexibility; and teamwork and collaboration. THE COLLEGE/ DEPARTMENT: The Saunders College of Business is served by 54 full-time faculty members who value collegiality and team work. The new hire will play an integral role in defining the direction of this program and developing new courses of interest. The successful candidate will help to build and grow this exciting new program.
- Candidates must have strong research skills and potential for scholarly research as demonstrated by publications in peer reviewed journals, and/or academic conference proceedings.
- Candidates should also have a demonstrated ability to teach effectively.
- For rank of Associate Professor, candidates must have a proven record of scholarly research and evidence of teaching excellence and strong service experience.
- All candidates should have a willingness to interact with business community and an ability to contribute in meaningful ways to the college's continuing commitment to cultural diversity, pluralism, and individual differences.
