## Faculty Position in Supply Chain Management

**Position**: The Raymond J. Harbert College of Business at Auburn University in Auburn, Alabama anticipates one opening starting Fall 2020, for a qualified **Assistant Professor** with the ability to teach in **Supply Chain Management**. **Qualifications**: Candidates must have an earned doctorate from an accredited business school in Supply Chain Management, Logistics, Operations Management, Management Science, or a closely related field upon start date. Additional qualifications include:

- Evidence or potential of the development of a strong research record based primarily in supply chain management.
- Evidence of teaching and/or research interests in supply chain management.
- Evidence of the ability to teach a variety of courses in the supply chain management program at all levels.
- Selected candidate must be legally authorized to work in the United States at the time of appointment and continue working legally for the term of employment.
- Excellent written, organizational and communication skills are required.

**Responsibilities**: Successful applicants will be expected to engage in high-quality research, evidenced by publications in leading academic journals, teach courses in the supply chain management program, and contribute to developing the future path for the department's growing programs.

**About the Program:** The Supply Chain Management program was ranked as the #3 undergraduate supply chain management program by Gartner in 2018. The faculty consists of an Eminent Scholar and six additional tenure track faculty, three lecturers, and two staff who support the professional development of supply chain management students. The Center for Supply Chain Innovation is sponsored by over a dozen firms who make a multi-year commitment to support faculty research and the curriculum. The supply chain faculty is known for its high quality research, exemplary teaching, and significant level of engagement in the supply chain industry.
