

The University of Oklahoma (OU) invites applicants to apply for an associate/full professor position in Supply Chain Management (SCM). This faculty position is part of a new university-wide strategic initiative in aerospace and defense (A&D). OU is committed to becoming a global leader in applied air, space and defense research and education; providing new levels of support and expertise to organizations in A&D. Part of this university-wide initiative includes launching a new Executive MBA program geared toward professionals in the A&D industry.

Applicants must hold a doctorate in SCM or related discipline. A record of experience with industry professionals in air, space or defense is preferred. Candidates are expected to provide strong teaching that offers an interface of academics and practice and a research program that includes publication in the most respected journals of the field such as *Management Science*, *Journal of Operations Management*, and *Production and Operations Management*. Qualified candidates may be eligible for an endowed faculty position.

Oklahoma possesses a fertile environment for research and development in aerospace and defense. This includes two of the largest MRO facilities in the world (Tinker AFB and American Airlines); five military installations, two air national guard operations, and numerous aerospace assets; one of only ten U.S. spaceports and the only one in unrestricted airspace; and home of the FAA Monroney Aeronautical Center and the National Weather Center.

The Price College of Business is AACSB-accredited with approximately 4,000 undergraduate, 500 master's, and 35 doctoral students. Its undergraduate program is ranked 50th by *U.S. News and World Report*, and its professional and full-time MBA programs are ranked 52nd and 58th. The University of Oklahoma is a Carnegie-R1 comprehensive public research university and enrolls almost 32,000 students, has more than 2,800 full-time faculty members, and has 21 colleges. OU became the first public institution ever to rank #1 nationally in the recruitment of National Merit Scholars. MBA classes are offered at the Gene Rainbolt Graduate School of Business, a 27,000-square foot facility located in the Innovation District of Oklahoma City. The Health Sciences Center campuses are located in Oklahoma City and Tulsa.
