Candidates who are close to completing their doctoral degree in supply chain management, logistics, sourcing, purchasing and supply management, or related areas are encouraged to apply. Assistant professors with prior experience will be considered. Teaching load is 2/2 for pre-tenure faculty and includes teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in logistics, sourcing, buyer supplier relationships, supply chain analytics, lean six sigma, operations management, decision sciences, and other related areas. Strong research and teaching potential are expected.
