

**Professor (Open Rank; tenure-track; part-time or full-time) in Logistics and
Academic Director of Executive Education
at Kühne Logistics University in Hamburg, Germany**

Kühne Logistics University (KLU) in Hamburg, Germany seeks applications from qualified candidates in Logistics. We are particularly interested to recruit a strong candidate with a background in fields such as logistics, transportation, purchasing, warehousing, 3PL management, sourcing and/or contract management, but also other topics in business logistics for a position of Professor (Open Rank) beginning any time in the year 2022.

This new faculty position at KLU in Hamburg will typically be initially for a 3-year period and be renewable for another 3 years, after which the faculty member will be up for tenure. These times are typically shortened if the initial appointment is at the Associate of Full Professor level.

Candidates must have a PhD in operations management, industrial engineering, or a related field and good industry contacts in the area of supply chains and/or logistics. Language of instruction is English. Although not a requirement, some knowledge of the German language would be an asset.

The successful candidate should

- publish their work in a manner which is appropriate for their specific field of research, preferable in collaboration with members of KLU's faculty,
- complement the research activity at KLU with the objective of strengthening the institution's reputation in practice,
- collaborate further with industry internationally and within Hamburg region,
- teach in KLU's degree programs as well as develop and deliver programs in KLU Executive Education; experience in innovative teaching formats and/or online learning would be particularly welcome; liaise with industry partners on promoting executive education,
- acquire a significant amount of external research funding for projects and build up a strong network within industry and academia to apply for national and international research grants, and be willing to assist others at KLU in acquiring funds from such sources,
- contribute to institution building.
