AAAS will convene a one-day workshop on Responsible Professional Practices in a Changing Research Environment. The 2013 AAAS Annual Meeting Workshop has as its theme, Professional Development and Responsible Science. Breakfast and lunch will be provided.

This workshop on professional development and responsible practice will be directed toward **trainees** (e.g., graduate students and post-docs) and **early career scientists**, and will cover such topics as responsible communication of research results, developing a successful research program, international collaborations, and giving and receiving good mentoring. More **senior faculty** interested in establishing or enhancing programs on career development and/or responsible conduct at their home institutions are also encouraged to attend. There will be special sessions for this group, focusing on implementing training and instructional strategies. Handouts will be provided to everyone, and trainees will also receive materials for use in teaching about the topics covered.
