Travel grants will be paid upon submission of all the conference-related receipts to the treasurer of the PDA, i.e. after you have attended the conference. The funds may be revoked in case the awardee is found ineligible for not fulfilling any of the following criterions:

- 1. Applicant must be a current MIT post-doc.
- 2. Must be presenting a talk/poster at a conference scheduled between July1st, 2016 to December 31st, 2016.
- 3. Have not received a past travel grant from the MIT PDA.
- 4. Submitted application only for a single conference.
- 5. At least, a part of the presented work MUST have been carried out at MIT, and the MIT PI should be a co-author.
- 6. Must NOT be currently an officer at MIT PDA.
