The Insight Data Science Fellows Program is an intensive, seven-week postdoctoral training fellowship that bridges the gap between academic research and a career in data science by matching Fellows with opportunities at Insight's partner companies. With offices in Silicon Valley, Boston, New York, Seattle, and Toronto, the program enables scientists to learn the industry-specific skills through a project-based, industry-driven learning approach designed to train academics in many of the cutting edge data science tools and practices used in industry. There are now over 2,000 Insight Fellows working as data scientists and data engineers on top data-driven teams including Facebook, the New York Times, Netflix, Twitter, Bloomberg, Apple, LinkedIn, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, Wayfair, McKinsey, Boston Consulting Group, and CVS Health, as well as at various well-funded startups.
