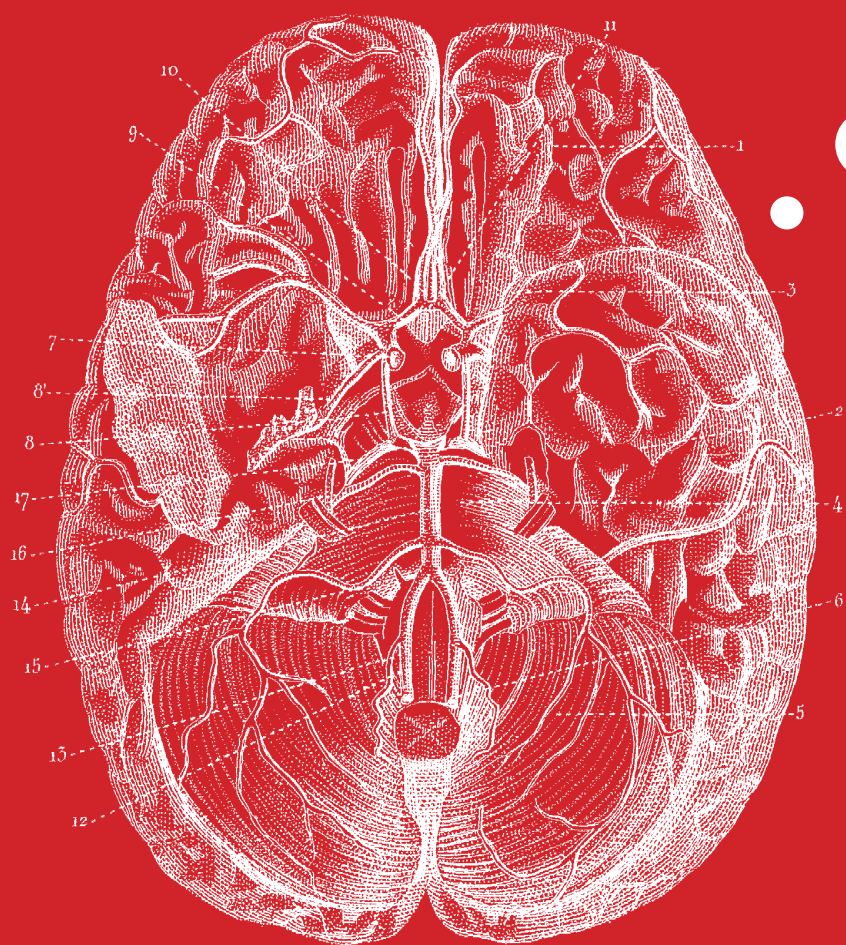


SOME REFLECTIONS ON THE DEARTH OF WOMEN IN SCIENCE
