**Greetings to the Catholic community at MIT!**

*Recently, I was intrigued by an invitation from Fr Michael Medas to consider offering anyone interested an opportunity for individual spiritual direction/ accompaniment on campus.*

*As an alum of The Harvard School of Public Health who took courses at MIT while in graduate school (many years ago!), I was drawn to the idea. So! On Sunday, March 17, I will be with you for the 9:30am liturgy to meet you and learn more of who you all are. I am looking forward to the day.*

*Are you wondering what spiritual direction/ accompaniment is? As I was trained in the Ignation way for this role, I quote Pope Francis:*

*“You go to your spiritual director to tell her/ him about the things that are going on in your heart, your spiritual emotions, your joys, your anger and what is going on inside you.” And he added: “Spiritual direction is not a clerical charism, it is a baptismal charism”.....in other words, a charism of the laity, one which may be found in an ordained minister but as a result of his baptism, not ordination.*

*I, myself, am a baptized, married laywoman with sons, daughters and grandchildren who has followed a winding path from an original career choice to a spiritual direction internship in 2005-6 and is grateful to God for all of it!*

*In this role, I see myself as a deep listener so that each person can bear God’s heart more deeply and clearly in their own heart by way of sharing with another who seeks God’s heart.*
