Cap Gap Relief	A student that has filed for H-1B gets automatic extension of F-1 status until October 1 of the fiscal year for which the H-1B visa is being requested	
When to Apply	Students on OPT As early as 90 days before until 60 days after OPT end	

Additional Paperwork

Student must write a Mentoring and Training Plan (MTP) signed by an employer and provide it to DSO prior to applying for STEM OPT Extension

until 60 days after it ends

Evaluations by employer every 6 months to be delivered to DSO
