Innovation



Team internal: started running collaboration meetings where each subteam runs an incomm-all meeting, cycling weekly; thinking about the latest MIT Enrolled Students Survey (ESS) numbers on student sadness (one-third of students have, in the past year, often or very often felt very sad)

Arts at MIT: mural collaboration with *Borderlines* underway (painting ongoing in the banana lounge); procured a piano (free) to be placed around campus for free play (<u>mitpiano_project</u>); exploring mobile art carts and the long-term creation of art makerspaces; preparing survey

Banana lounge: hosting Banana Lounge anniversary on Friday (5/3) + cardboard box hackathon on Saturday (5/4); working with *ActiveMinds* in response to notes of students struggling in the lounge + put out student help resources; daily showcase of where bananas are from + the people behind them; working with suppliers to increase quality and reduce food waste; laser cutting coasters for the banana baskers to encourage student self replenishment; studied power socket use and have nine more power strips now; more plants; introduced banana plants; banana consumption increased (~4000/week); extra compost bin being organized; weekly vacuum organized; weekly clean by UA Innovation members; hosting in-lounge cleaning supplies; more paper; expanded non-caffeinated options; paper towels; online feedback form; study breaks with MindHandHeart; hosting *good grub* pilot (below); exploring options to improve bathrooms nearby

<u>ua-innovation-c</u> BetterMIT: compiling a report on learnings from the Spring '19 Better MIT design challenge event

Campus corners: investigating spaces for collaborative play (a "playground") and for napping (separate spaces); preparing survey

Community centers: long-term exploration for social space on campus

Good grub: running a healthy food delivery pilot (*Clover, Whole Heart Provisions,* and *Life Alive,* at the moment) to Banana Lounge, prototyping infrastructures to allow better--cheaper, tastier, healthier--and more accessible food options on campus

Beyond MIT: launched "fun funds," an experiment to help students get off campus and explore worlds beyond MIT; exploring alternative ways to connect students to communities and worlds beyond MIT

Space of Quiet: continuing our development of 50-305 as a space for reflection and contemplation, working with the *MIT Office of Religious, Spiritual and Ethical Life*; ran a student survey to hear ideas and concerns (901 responses); presented to UA Council (3/13); lounge furnishings are almost completed; seeking an early May opening


