

Saint Michael's Playhouse - Production Internship

About Saint Michael's Playhouse :

Owned and operated by Saint Michael's College, Saint Michael's Playhouse is an award-winning equity theater company recognized by The Drama League in NYC as "One of the best regional theater companies in America." Featuring talent from Broadway, Off-Broadway, and regional theaters nationwide and housed in one of the finest theater facilities in the state of Vermont, the Playhouse attracts approximately 15,000 theatergoers each season. Additionally, the Playhouse's nationally recognized internship program has been the springboard for many successful careers in professional theater across the country. The Playhouse operates under contract with Actors' Equity Association as a member of the Council of Resident Stock Theaters.

Job Description:

All Playhouse interns receive a \$200 weekly stipend plus room and board (consisting of 10 meals per week). Seeking: scenic intern, costume intern, prop intern, electricians intern, sound intern, stage management intern, and general production interns to rotate within production departments. Interns are trained by and work closely with professional supervisors, directors, designers, staff and equity actors. Schedules are rigorous; interns train with day AND evening crews. Internship runs from June 1 - August 12, 2012, producing four professional equity productions, NUNSENSE, UNNECESSARY FARCE, OVER THE PUB, FOREVER PLAID, and two non-equity children's theater productions.

Requirements:

Seeking candidates with previously acquired skills in a variety of areas of production. Applicants must show a strong interest in furthering their professional development and a commitment to working in an equity stock theater.

Additional Information:

Hiring is contingent upon eligibility to work in the United States and a successful completion of a background check.
